- Complete a professional development action plan and have discussions with the IMP Coordinator or a building mentor
- Complete the four reflection activities from year 2 of the IMP and have discussions with the IMP Coordinator or a building mentor
- Complete six activities involving the Common Core State Standards at your new grade level and have discussions with the IMP Coordinator or a building mentor
- Any other reasonable request for support
