



## Lead Hazard Reduction- Home improvement program

- **Do you have children under the age of 6?**
- **Do you live in Berwyn, Blue Island, Calumet City, Calumet Park, Cicero, Dolton, Maywood, Riverdale, Robbins or Summit?**
  - **Was your home built before 1978?**



The Cook County Department of Public Health (CCDPH) was recently awarded a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

This grant will correct lead paint hazards in homes for families that qualify. A family may qualify for the grant program if their income is below the program limit, and if there are lead hazards in their home.

Families that are accepted in the program will receive a home inspection to look for lead paint hazards. If there are hazards, CCDPH will work with a licensed contractor to come to your home and fix the hazards, at no cost to you. Work that is typically done to fix lead hazards could be things like painting, replacing windows, or other home repair work to remove or contain the lead paint.
