**Registration Information for Kindergarten, Grade 1, Grade 5,  
Out-of-State Transfers**

**Kindergarten**

Prior to enrollment parents must present the following information:

- Proof of residency
- Birth certificate to verify that the child is 5 years of age, on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year
- Physical examination form documenting immunization requirements

**Grade 1**

Any child entering grade 1 who has not attended kindergarten must meet the same requirements as a kindergarten child and be 6 years of age, on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year.

**Grade 5**

Students entering grade 5 are required to have a current physical examination prior to enrollment.

**Out-of-State Transfers**

Any student entering Illinois schools from, out of state, is required to have a physical examination prior to enrollment.

**Registration Information for non-attending children:**

- Parent-Infant** (0-3 years old)
- Early Childhood** (3-5 years old)
- Private school students** (5-14 years old)

The school district is responsible for evaluating any child, living within the district boundaries, who is suspected of having a disability.

Parents must register in the district to document proof of residency and age. It is not necessary for the parent to provide a physical examination, transfer, or report card. No fees are collected, until the child begins attending District 148 schools.

Registration packets for children between the ages of 0-5 should be forwarded to the Early Childhood Center.

Registration packets for private school students whose parents are requesting an evaluation should be sent to Support Programs.
