Illinois State Transfer Form – Out-of-State Transfers-In

In accordance with Section 2-3. 13a of the School Code, regarding student transfers, all public school districts are to have parent/guardian certification in writing that the out-of-state transfer in student is not currently serving a suspension or expulsion imposed by the school from which the student is transferring. No public school district is required to admit a new student who is transferring from an out-of-state public school unless the student transfers in, is in "Good Standing." "In Good Standing" means that the student is not being disciplined by an out-of-suspension or expulsion, and is entitled to attend classes, as of the date of this form.
