PHYSICAL FORM NOTICE FOR STUDENTS

Attached physical form must be completed and returned to school on Registration Day for your child to enter school.

The Illinois School Code requires that all children entering Illinois schools for the first time, and again in sixth grade, have a physical, eye, dental examination and immunizations forms before they will be admitted to school in the Fall. These immunizations must be updated and indicate month, day, and year given. It is strongly recommended that children between 6 months and 6 years provide a statement from a physician that the child has been screened for lead poisoning. The physician must sign the physical examination form in two places to verify that all immunizations have been administered to the child.

Please make your appointment early in order to allow sufficient time to complete the required immunizations.

If the physical condition of the child is such that the doctor feels any of the immunizing agents are not indicated, a statement from the physician to this effect is required.

Any refusals because of religious beliefs must be accompanied by a written statement from a religious affiliation administrator. A form is available from the school nurse.

Cook County Department of Public Health provides school physicals at no cost for those families who qualify. Call 708/210-4500 for information.
