## Language

## Literacy

Demonstrates auditory blending - Rhyme Time (3)

Recalls facts from story he or she read - Stepping Stones (3)

Retells story he or she read - Stepping Stones (8)

Demonstrates increasing facility with the process of writing - G, R & W (4-10), Write Away (7-10)

Reads simple, phonetically controlled text accurately - Stepping Stones (4, 9)

Identifies story elements - Story Tree (6)

Recognizes some sight words - G, R & W (6-10)

Identifies some upper and lowercase letters - Stepping Stones (6)

Writes readable sentences with approximated spelling - Write Away (7-10)

## Language

Understands and uses prepositions - Outside Play (1-10)

Distinguishes between real and imaginary situations - Library Lab (1-5)

Listens attentively to stories - Story Tree (2-10)

Elaborates responses with justifications - Spotlight On (2-10), Let's Think About It (2-10)

Asks questions leading to discussions - Spotlight On (6-10), Let's Think About It (6-10)

## Literacy

Demonstrates awareness of the function of writing - Blocks Lab (1-10)

Identifies initial, final and medial phonemes in words - Literacy Lab (1-5)

Demonstrates auditory segmenting - Write Away (1-10)

Blends sounds to read words - G, R & W (1-10), Stepping Stones (4, 9)

Reads some sight words - G, R & W (1-10)

Makes predictions about stories previously read - Stepping Stones (2, 7)

Recalls facts from story previously read - Stepping Stones (3)

Answers higher order questions about text previously read - Stepping Stones (5, 10)

Retells story previously read - Stepping Stones (8)
