**NOTICE TO PARENTS OF ALL NEW REGISTRANTS**

District policy is such that, when necessary, in-coming students may be assigned to a district school other than the home school due to large class size in a particular grade. While we make every attempt to assign a child to his/her home school, that is not always possible because of fluctuating class size.

Should it be necessary to assign your child to an alternate school for enrollment purposes, you will be notified.

Parents of in-coming students who have been fraudulently enrolled will be immediately transferred out of the district and will be billed for each day that the student was enrolled.

**SCHOOL DISTRICT 148 RESERVES THE RIGHT AND AUTHORITY TO DETERMINE NEW STUDENT GRADE PLACEMENT.**

As per Board of Education policy, all incoming students in grades 1-6 will be placed in the grade level indicated on his/her transfer.

The new student will:

1. remain in the grade level on his/her transfer
2. remain in the grade level on his/her transfer for a month pending a review of the student's work.
  - a. if the student's work is at grade level the child will remain in his/her appropriate grade.
  - b. if the student's work is below grade level the school reserves the right to place the child one grade level below the grade indicated on the transfer.
