PHYSICAL FORM NOTICE FOR STUDENTS

Attached physical form must be completed and returned to school on Registration Day for your child to enter school.

The Illinois School Code requires that all children entering Illinois schools for the first time, and again in sixth grade, have a physical, eye, dental examination and immunizations forms before they will be admitted to school in the Fall. These immunizations must be updated and indicate **month, day, and year** given. It is strongly recommended that children between 6 months and 6 years provide a statement from a physician that the child has been screened for lead poisoning. The physician must sign the physical examination form in **two** places to verify that all immunizations have been administered to the child.

Please make your appointment **early** in order to allow sufficient time to complete the required immunizations.

If the physical condition of the child is such that the doctor feels any of the immunizing agents are not indicated, a statement from the physician to this effect is required.

Any refusals because of religious beliefs must be accompanied by a written statement from a religious affiliation administrator. A form is available from the school nurse.

Cook County Department of Public Health provides school physicals at no cost for those families who qualify. Call 708/210-4500 for information.

Physical and Immunization Requirements for Students Entering
KINDERGARTEN

1. **HEALTH EXAMINATION** – conducted within one year
 - Physical Exam – signed and dated by doctor
 - Immunizations – signed and dated by doctor
 - Medical History – filled out and signed by parent
 - Physical Education – checked off by doctor

2. **REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS**
 - DPT – 4 or more doses – last booster after 4th birthday
 - Polio – 3 or more doses – last booster after 4th birthday
 - Mumps – 1 dose after 12 months of age
 - Measles (Rubeola) – 2 doses – 1st dose after 2 months, 2nd dose no less than one month later
 - Rubella – 1 dose after 12 months of age
 - Varicella vaccine

Students not meeting the above requirements by the first day of school will be excluded from school.

3. **TUBERCULOSIS SKIN TEST** – Mantoux type

4. **LEAD ASSESSMENT** – state requirement
LEAD SCREENING BLOOD TEST (if indicated) – Indicate on the health form the date the assessment/test was administered by your physician.

5. **DENTAL EXAMINATION** – required

6. **Eye Examination** - required
