- Encourage your child to have a positive attitude.

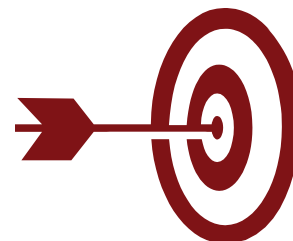
- Encourage your child to wear eye glasses, if needed.
