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





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Charlotte's Advice on Engagement



PHASE 3 Engaging Students in Learning	Examples of teacher/classroom actions
1e – Planning Coherent Instruction	Hunter lesson design, clearly explain the purpose of the session, use small group instruction as you would in the classroom, test drive new activities before using with students, video tape some lessons
3b – Using Questioning and Discussion Techniques	Use breakout discussions, when a student respond require all students to comment on the response, allow students to share their work in discussions and when answering questions, create online discussion spaces
3c – Engaging Students in Learning	Pacing & Brain Breaks, use infographics and videos, consider ways for students to share their thinking, allow students to submit work in a variety of forms, create choices, allow student to collaborate and research topics






