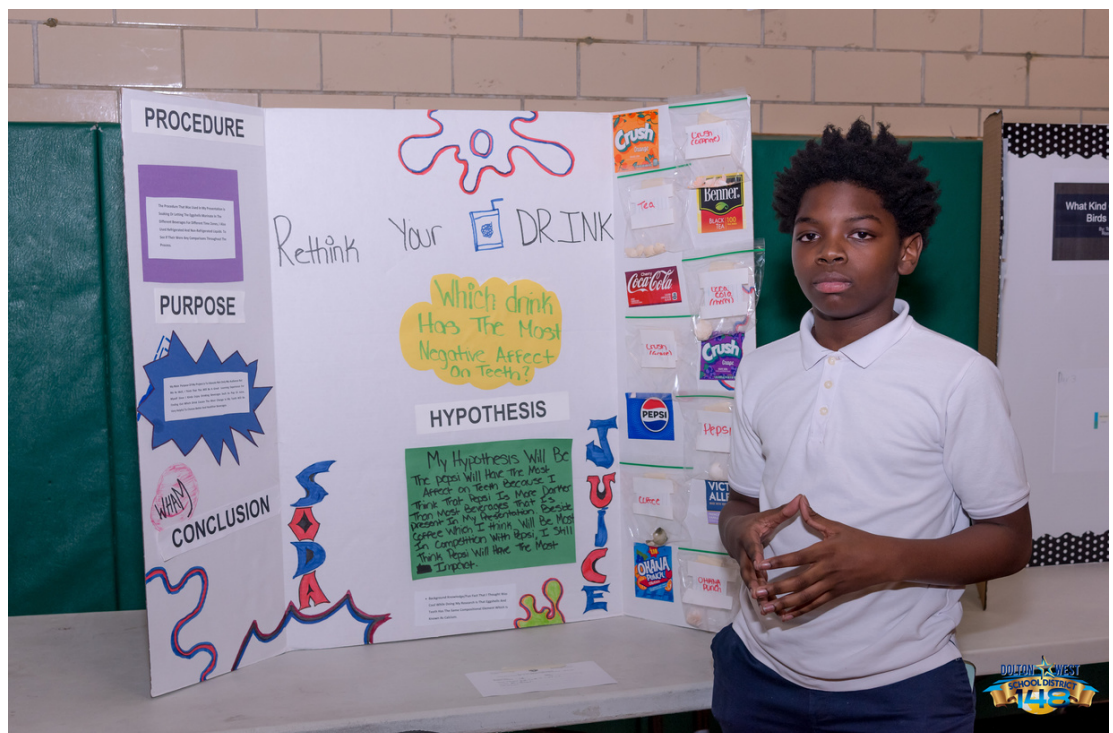

Sixth graders learned about bats and created headlamps that would help them see the animals in dark caves.

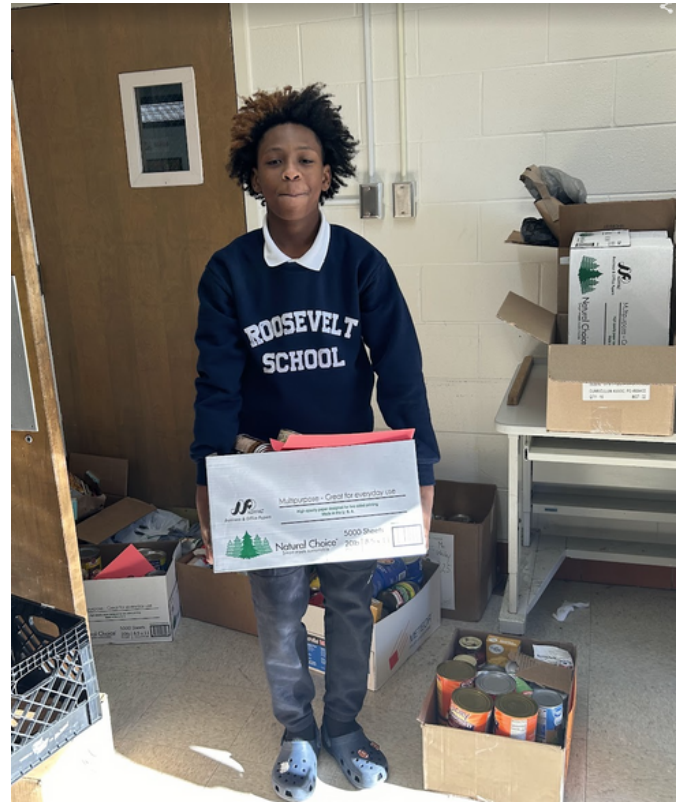

On Friday, January 19, 2024, we will host our Classroom Spelling Bee. One winner from every classroom will advance to the school-wide Spelling Bee.

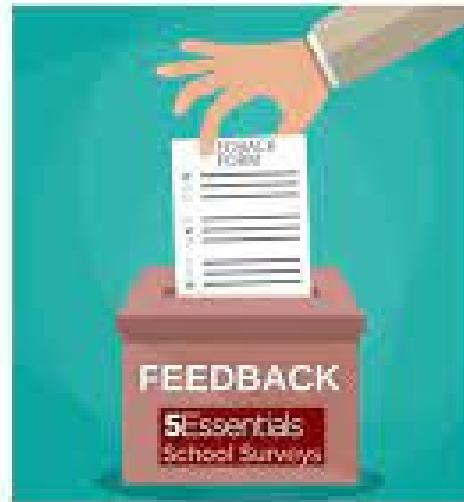
